Respective Functions

The Board of Governors has drawn up the school's admissions criteria and has delegated to the principal its function and responsibility in relation to the application of the criteria and the admission of pupils to the school.

Admissions Criteria

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria punctual applications will be considered before late applications are considered. The application procedure **opens on 7 January 2021 at 12noon** (GMT) and an application submitted by the **closing date of 29 January 2021 at 12noon** (GMT) will be treated as a punctual application. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 29 January 2021 will be treated as a late application.

Only children of compulsory school age, (i.e. children aged 4 on or before 1 July preceding the September admission) will be admitted to the school.

In the event of the school being oversubscribed the Governors will select children for admission to Primary 1 using the admissions criteria set out below. The criteria will be applied in the order in which they are set down.

- 1 Children who have brothers/sisters, half-brothers/half-sisters or Looked After Children living permanently at the same address currently attending Knocknagoney Primary School (P1-P7). (**Indicate name and year group**)
- 2 Children who attended the Nursery Unit in the school year 2020-21.
- 3 Children who live nearest the school. Distance will be determined by a straight line measurement from the front door of the child's home to the entrance to the school. Measurement will be generated electronically using the Ordnance Survey Measuring tool.

In the event of 2 or more children's permanent residence being measured equal distance for the final place children will be selected by age with the oldest being selected first.

When considering which children should be selected for admission, the Board of Governors will only take into account information which is detailed on the application or provided directly to the school. Parents/Guardians should therefore ensure that all information pertaining to their child and relevant to the school's admissions criteria is stated on the application or provided directly to the first preference school. Examples of such information include whether the child has brothers/sisters attending the school, or is the eldest child in the family.

Duty to Verify

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any Application.

The Governors request that all applicants provide the following documentation to the school by 12 noon on Friday 5 February 2021:

An original birth certificate for the child (either long or short)
Any **two** of the following to verify the child's home address:

- *A recent bank or building society statement which shows the address at which the child is resident*
- *A recent utility bill (electricity, gas, television licence or phone) which shows the address at which the child is resident*
- *A recent letter awarding child benefit to the child or another recent letter relating to this benefit*
- *Electoral Identification*
- *Driving Licence for parent/ guardian showing the address at which the child is resident*
- *A recent payslip*
- *A recent mortgage or rental document*
- *A recent land/ property document*

Recent documents are defined as being within the last 6 months, with the exception of mortgage or land property documents, where within the last year is accepted.

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors by the deadline given, this may result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

Waiting List Policy

Should a vacancy arise after Wednesday 28 April all applications for admission to P1, that were initially refused, new applications, late applications and applications where new information has been provided will be treated equally and the published criteria applied. This waiting list will be in place until 30 June 2022.

The school will contact you in writing if your child gains a place in the school by this method.

Your child's name will be automatically added to the list. Please contact the school if you wish for your child's name to be removed from the list.
