

Behaviour

- Class rules: displayed in classroom. Children have come up with these themselves.
- •'Give me Five': visual reminders for carpet time andfor lining up.
- •Star reward chart: Children have to collect 10 stars to get into the prize box.
- •<u>Dina School:</u> focusing on encouraging positive behaviours and creating a positive learning environment.

Behaviour ctd.

- •Strategies used for undesirable behaviour: non-verbal cues, ignoring (when appropriate), rules reminder, re-direction to another activity, 2 minutes loss of free play/privilege.
- Time Out: used for physical/aggressive behaviour.

Key Words



Key word book:

Words will be part of High Frequency Word List — generally linked to in school reading book / topic.

Reading




Reading books are read in school Monday - Wednesday. 2 books per week with one written reading activity in school.

Huge focus on comprehension in P.2 – encouraging them to read beyond the words: empathising, humour, reading aloud with expression.

Use inside covers of reading books to support their understanding and ideas for questioning.


Bug Club

Spellings



Spellings introduced at children's pace

Generally start after Christmas — CVC words, rhyming families

For now - Focus on key words in reading books.

-Encourage your child your find words, write them, come up with their own sentences, etc.

Initially for familiarity, practise and reinforcement

Usernames and passwords will be sent home — certificates given out when points achieved: bronze, silver, gold

Seesaw App



This provides opportunities for parents to share in their child's learning journey.

Photographs are taken in school and uploaded onto the App. Only linked adults are able to view these.

Please inform us if you have not yet connected as notes etc are also sent home this way.

Snack, dinners and packed lunches

- School Money account
- Snack is £2.50 per week Healthy break inc. pancakes, brioche, cheese, ham, selection of fruit, yogurts. Children assist serving and tidy up.
- Milk is paid for on a termly basis, this can be paid for using School Money payment system. Water is the alternative and is provided.
- Dinners are £2.60 per day, and should be selected and paid for using School Money. FSM should also be selected this way.
- Packed lunches should have 3 / 4 items, eg. wrap, yogurt and piece of fruit

Sun Rise and Waiting Clubs

- P1 P7 children can attend Sun Rise club from 8.00am. The cost is £1.50 per day and will be added to your School Money account after each attendance.
- P1-P3 (currently) are able to attend Waiting Club until 3pm. The cost is £3 per day and should be booked <u>in advance</u> on School Money (preferably at least 1 day before.)
- Waiting Club may be extended to 4pm should there be enough demand. Please email: info@knocknagoney.belfast.ni.sch.uk

Meetings with Teachers

- Parent Consultations are usually held in October and February. These are planned for this year, dependent on current EA Guidance.
- Annual Reports will be issued in June.
- If you need to speak to a teacher about something please send in a note to arrange an appointment.

General

- Punctuality in mornings and afternoons, as we don't want your child to become distressed if they miss the lesson introduction, or are the last to be collected.
- Please check Seesaw and School Website for notes.
- If your child is unwell please telephone the school office on the first morning of illness.
- Please make us aware of any medical conditions / health issues / allergies, as we do baking / food activities throughout the year.

- orally ordering and sequencing numbers


· Topic Maths
